In addition to the just-announced Innovation by Design recognition, St. Patrick's Island Park has received the 2016 Excellence on the Waterfront award from the nonprofit Waterfront Center, the 2015 President's Award of Excellence for Design from ASLA Colorado, a 2015 Regional Merit Award in the landscape management category from the Canadian Society of Landscape Architects (CSLA) and a Merit
